problem

Client became intoxicated in a hotel bar. When confronted by police, client bolted to the parking lot, screaming and yelling. Client was charged with disturbing the peace.

solution

We rejected the state's lousy plea offer and had a trial. The state called two witnesses, the bar manager and the arresting police officer, to testify about client's behavior. The bar manager testified about other patrons, and the officer testified about hotel room guests, who saw client's behavior. Neither witness could answer my question: Were those who saw and heard client disturbed or just curious?

result

With no evidence that anyone was disturbed, as opposed to curious, by my client's behavior, the judge found client not guilty and he left court without punishment.
