problem

An African-American male client was in a car with a friend parked in a McDonald's parking lot late at night. The manager was scared and called police to investigate. Officers surrounded client's car, detained my client and searched his car. Client was charged with possession of controlled dangerous substances (CDS).

solution

Conducted a Motion Hearing to suppress the evidence because the search violated constitutional guarantees against unreasonable searches.

result

Because the police could not describe any criminal activity prior to the search, the evidence was suppressed. My client was found not guilty. He left court without punishment.
